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OVERVIEW

Millennium India Education Foundation (MIEF) jointly with Ministry of Earth Sciences Government of India celebrated the World Earth Day 2019 for on 22nd & 24th April 2019 by organizing inter-school competitions and exhibition at Mount Abu Public School, Sector 5, Rohini, Delhi and Vishwa Bharati Public School, Sector 28, Noida respectively.

350 students from 46 schools of Delhi & Noida took part in **inter-school** competitions and which comprised of Debate ,Movie Making ,Painting Competition and Bird House Making Painting at **Mount Abu School Rohini New Delhi** on 22nd April 2019 and Folk Art Painting ,Doodle painting 4 Earth and Street Play at **Vishwa Bharati Public School Noida** on 24th April 2019.

Theme of all the competitions was “Protect Our Species”.

Sh Ashok Saha Scientist Ministry of Earth Sciences and Dr B C Sabata Mr.Senior Scientific Officer Dept.of Environment Govt.of NCT Delhi were the **chief guests** at Mount Abu Public School Rohini Delhi & Vishwa Bharati Public School Noida respectively. Both the guests distributed the prizes and certificates to competition winners in different categories and all participants. Although Ministry of Earth sciences has supported only painting competition activity at Mount Abu Public School Rohini, New Delhi, MIEF went ahead by celebrating the event at 2 venues as it has been doing so for last 5 years or so.

Prize winning paintings have been submitted to the Ministry of Earth Sciences as desired by the ministry. The W.E.D celebrations were covered widely in many national newspapers .

विश्व पृथ्वी दिवस पर स्कूलों में प्रतियोगिताएं

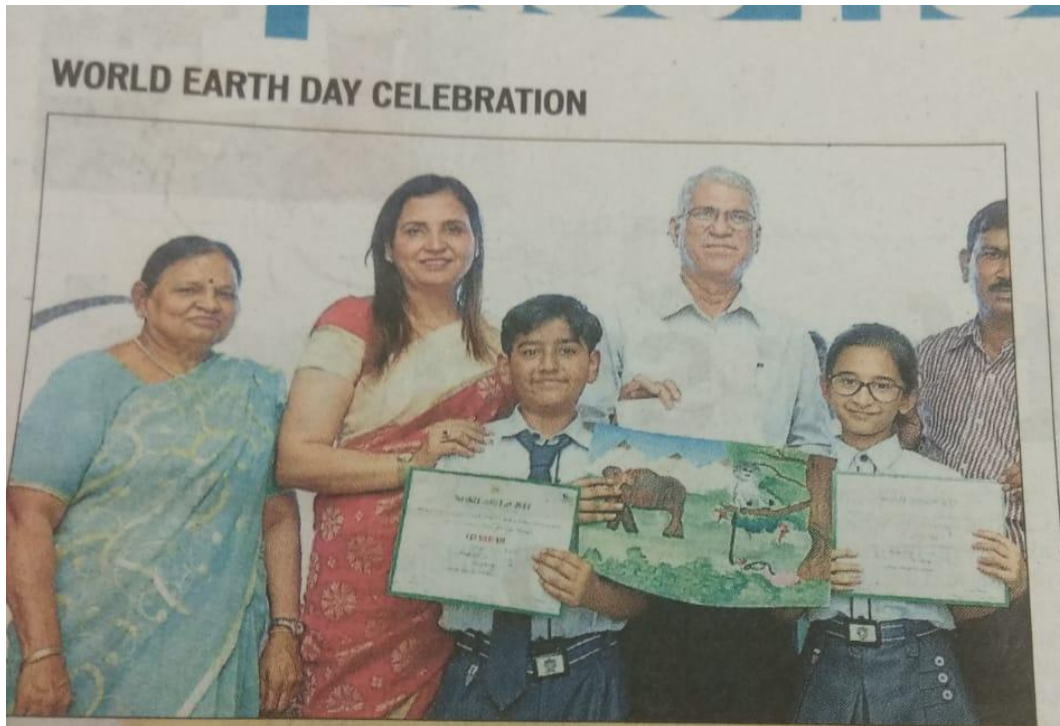

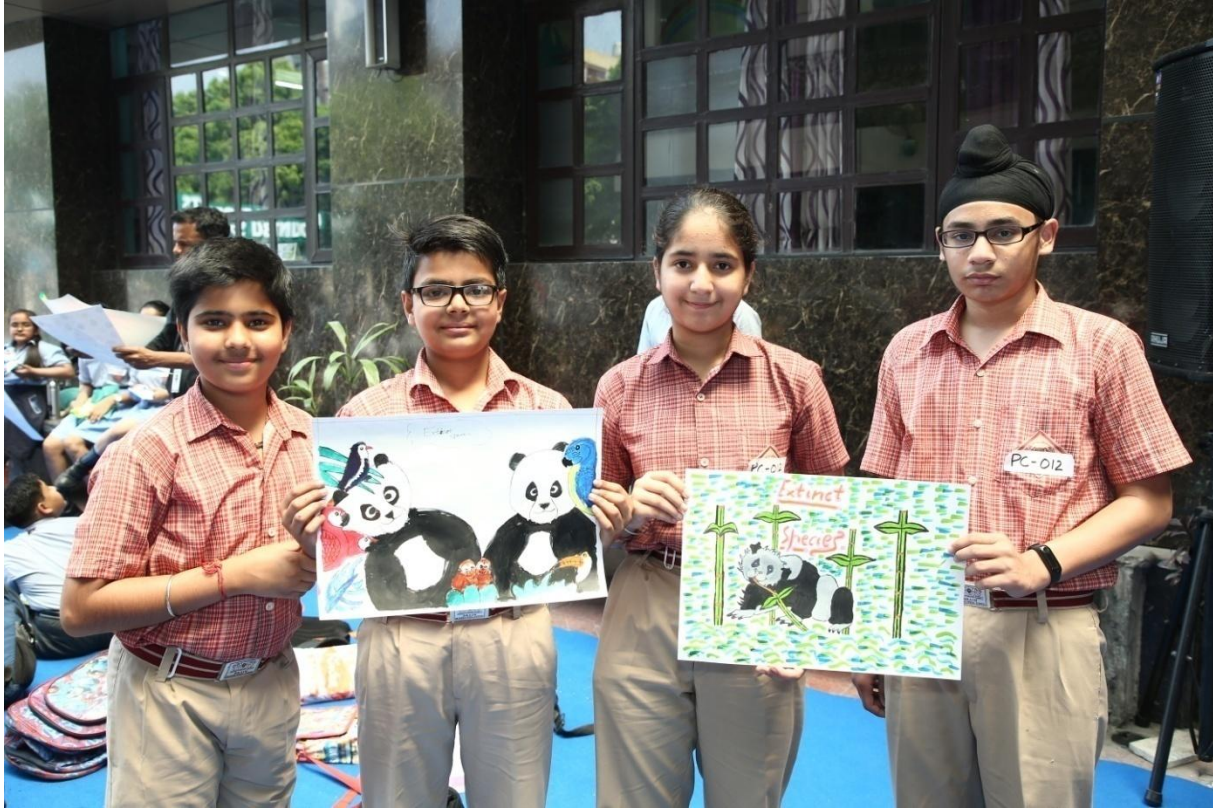
